Daughter of Saviour and Jane nee' Farrugia, born in Sliema in September of 1969. She received her primary education at Stella Maris School (Balzan) and St. Dorothy's Convent School (Sliema) and her secondary education at St. Dorothy's Convent School (Mdina) and at the Jesuit College of St. Aloysious (1985 to 1987). In 1991 she obtained her Diploma of Notary Public from the University of Malta and in 1993 she graduated as Doctor of Laws from the same University with a dissertation on trade marks. She was called to the Bar in 1994.

Prior to her appointment to the Bench of Magistrate, Dr Demicoli was a litigation lawyer specialising in civil and commercial law, insurance law and intellectual property law. For a number of years she also occupied the post of part-time judicial assistant attached the First Hall of the Civil Court. In 2000 she was appointed as Adjudicator on the Small Claims Tribunal. In March 2003 she was appointed as a Chairperson of the Industrial Tribunal and in March 2005 was also appointed as Umpire presiding over the Social Security Appeals Board. In February 2006 she was appointed Commissioner for Justice (Valletta Tribunal). She was also one of the arbitrators on the official list of arbitrators of the Malta Arbitration Centre and was regularly appointed as a private arbitrator by insurance companies in relation to traffic accidents. On the 19th September 2006 she was appointed a Magistrate and assigned duties in the Court of Magistrates (Malta) as a Court of Criminal Judicature.
